Viva Farms is a non-profit Farm Business Incubator & Training Program. Our mission is to empower aspiring and limited-resource farmers by providing bilingual training in holistic organic farming practices, as well as access to land, infrastructure, equipment, marketing and capital.

> What is the Practicum in Sustainable Agriculture?

It's a land based, hands-on course in certified organic production & small farm business management that takes place over an entire farming season.

Who should enroll?

- · People interested in organic crop production and starting their own farm business.
- Farmworkers who want to become farm owners.
- People with a passion for agriculture, environmental stewardship, food & resilient communities.

▶ What is taught during the course?

Certified Organic Production:

- · Certified organic production
- Seed propagation & greenhouse management

Graduates of the Practicum will be eligible to apply to participate in the Viva Farms incubator as an independent operator of their farm business.

How much does it cost?

Viva Farms will not turn anyone away from the program due to lack of funds. Base tuition is \$1200. We also welcome community-supporter level tuition and have scholarships and payment plans available. When is it?

Class meets weekly on Tuesday evenings from April to November

Where is it?

The Practicum is offered at our student farms in Burlington in Skagit County (English and Spanish), and in Woodinville in King County (English only). Participants will complete the entire course at the location where they apply to. Online learning is not available.

What is the time commitment?

6 hours/week: Tuesdays from 5:30pm-7:30pm + 4 hours minimum independent work
